Residents in this 40-bed low care facility are encouraged to participate in committees and to be active in their lifestyle decision-making.

ANZAC Hostel is fully accredited and offers

- Single rooms, with private ensuite facilities
- Resident Focussed Care with trained staff on duty 24 hours
- Respite Care
- Meals cooked fresh daily on the premises
- Comprehensive recreation and therapy programs
- A bus for regular outings
- Close relationships with local RSL Clubs
- Strong volunteer base
- Linen and laundry services
- Access to the ANZAC Day Therapy Centre, which provides additional activities and programs
- Access to specialist health professionals, such as podiatry

Admission and Charges

Accommodation is offered as a priority to war widows, veterans and their dependants, with applications from the general public welcome.

All prospective residents must have been assessed by an Aged Care Assessment Service as requiring low level care.

Charges, including bonds, are in line with the Aged Care Act 1997.
